We are open 5 days a week and have:

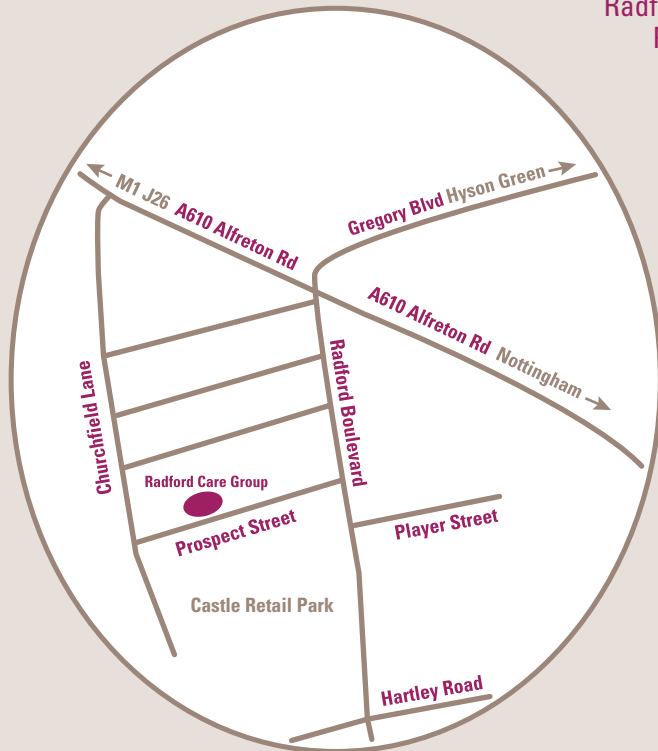
